- Padraig Crumlin (Paddy) went to sea in the Australian Merchant Navy in 1978.
- He has been a full-time union official since 1988 including Branch Secretary and Assistant National Secretary of the Seamen's Union of Australia and after amalgamation with the Waterside Workers' Federation of Australia in 1993, became the Deputy National Secretary and subsequently the National Secretary of the Maritime Union of Australia.
- Paddy has wide involvement in the port authority, towage, shipping, hydrocarbon, diving, cruise ship and stevedoring industries in Australia and Internationally
- Paddy is President of the International Transport Workers' Federation (ITF) and was re-elected for a second term in August 2014. Paddy has also held the positions of Chair of the Dockers Section and as an Executive Member of the ITF since August 2006.
- Paddy has represented international seafarers at the International Labor Organisation on maritime conventions for over 15 years in a senior capacity
