- Through the breakfast, we were able to donate to Mettle Women Inc. a charity that operates a national gift delivery service that is staffed by women who are experiencing homelessness as a result of domestic & family violence. With profits from their social enterprise sales, they support survivors with paid work and training, scholarships, crisis funds, mental health support and childcare support.

Participants gained an insight into the barriers for reporting workplace sexual harassment; seeking help an commencing legal proceedings in Western Australia and Australia. The learnings and observations that were shared enabled participants to identify and discuss opportunities in how they could, in their own roles, contribute to breaking down these barriers and think about finding alternative solutions for persons targeted by sexual harassment.

- There was much positive feedback and requests for IRSWA to run this again which we hope to do so with Piddington on an annual basis.


